



If you are not tired of my adventures in Alaska, I will just quickly tell you a little more.

We then returned to Anchorage and stopped at Potters Marsh and saw a female moose wandering around the marsh, super! Back for another visit to the Orthopedic Surgeon and he was happy with my arm and organized visits to coinside with our itinery which was great. Our next adventure was to Kodiak Island for another bear watching tour, sea plane over the island, fantastic scenery, then landed almost beside a bear, walked around a spit of land to a dam and saw another bear catching fish and later a sow and her cub came and entertained us for ages. Back to Anchorage again and then off to an Inside Passage Cruise via a super train. We went Gold classs and were therefore able to sit in the observation car all the way, once again fantastic scenery.



I won't go into too much detail of our cruise, thoroughly spoilt living, but one of the highlights was the Hubbard Glacier, within O.4 mile, magnificent! Then a helicopter flight with a dog sled ride on a glacier. Unbelievable! After the Cruise we went to Prince Rupert which was actually in Canada and the only night we spent outside of Alaska. Here we again went on a sea plane to see bears, only one this time. Very isolated place

with a family camping there all summer and taking tourists around in their boat. The next morning we caught the Marine Highway Ferry and spent a day going through several islands to Wrangell.

If you are contemplating going to Alaska at any time, this is the place NOT to miss!! We went to Anan Bear Sanctuary and had an absolutely wonderful day watching the bears, black ones at the falls and brown ones further down the river. I can't find enough words to tell you how much we enjoyed that day. The next one was a day to the Le Conte' Glacier, jet boat and even touched an iceberg. Yes even with my arm in plaster, the driver got me close enough. The blues of the ice were just magic. To top it all off we went the next day on a cruise up the

Vale Patrick McMahon

"Pat" McMahon a stalwart of Greenwich Swingers Square Dance Club for over 30 years died on 12th November 2012. He was 97.

His vitality and positive attitude to life was amazing. At 90 he represented the club in a convention dressed square, was still playing tennis and also still happily working part time for the Australian Bureau of Statistics and had no plans to retire. "I thought about it at one stage, maybe 10 years ago, but why give up something you love?" he asked.

Pat regretted that he came into square dancing relatively late in life, at the Blue Pacific Club, Rose Bay, in 1982 after he lost his wife. There he met members of the Greenwich Swingers, with which he linked up a year later.


He said of square dancing: "It has made an enormous difference to my life, has kept me active, mentally agile and afforded a great deal of pleasure. You can start the evening feeling a little down. Then five minutes with the music and the rhythm and it's all gone. There's a lot of laughter in square dancing."

In 2005, the club celebrated Pat McMahon's 90th birthday. The party was called "This is your Life", and traced his life and history. Five years later the club celebrated Pat's 95th birthday, and, as Pat was still dancing, he was elected "President" for the night. For the occasion, Bill Seymour had made and wheeled out a large birthday cake; when Pat cut the cake, out jumped "Marilyn Monroe" (Pegg) singing "Happy birthday Mr President". It was a lot of fun and Pat played it up to the hilt. It was a celebration of a remarkable person and inspiration to all in the square dance world.

Pat was a real asset to the club, always contributing with the work as well as encouraging newcomers.

The congregation at his funeral service overflowed the church and celebrated a life well lived. Comments from some who knew him, and could not attend summed up the esteem and affection in which he was held. "He was a lovely man and a great square dancer", "Pat was a wonderful person", "He was an impressive person", "...he was very special person". "Pat was such a wonderful person, so vibrant considering his age".

Never was there a better example that "We do not grow too old to dance. We grow old because we do not dance"





A good sized contingent is now looking forward to travelling east in April to Gosford for the National Convention.




