Firstly, CONGRATULATIONS and THANKS for the effort put in by clubs throughout Australia and New Zealand during 2013 as we continued to enjoy our dancing, our friends and the other benefits gained through clogging. It's wonderful to so often have heard over the past weeks the burning question: "When do we start dancing again?" even though I am sure our diaries and calendars have the start-up dates clearly marked. Check with your club leader if you aren't sure when to lace up the shoes and hit the floorboards dancin'.

There weren't many who missed the news of Olive Borovsky's 80th Birthday Bash in mid-December. Truly remarkable that the clogging community, with the aid of Olive's daughter, Michele, was able to keep it a secret right up to the point where, as they entered the tree-lined driveway to Double Jingle's Hall at Lutwyche, Olive commented that it looked as if Double Jingle were putting on a little morning tea for her, hence the cars lining the sides of the driveway, only to be totally blown away at the sight of a cheering packed dance floor as she walked through the hall's doorway. Lost for words is a new experience for our Olive, but this was one of those occasions when even someone like Olive had this wonderful happening of finding out how much the clogging community love and respect this talented lady: and receiving three separate renditions of 'Happy Birthday to You" during the day was the icing on the cake. ### The ACA National Dance List for 2013/2014 is out.

The Easy Intermediate dances that went from the list were: Ballad of St Anne's Reel, Except For Monday, Grandpa's Fiddle, The Deadwood Stage and The Reel, replaced by: Barefoot and Buckwild, Istanbul Not Constantinople, Now I Can Dance, Settle Down, and The Wind.

Intermediate dances no longer on the list: Bad Romance, Jai Ho, Love Story and The House That Never Was, replaced by Dance Again, Put You in a Song, the Showcase winner from the 2013 Convention Rockabilly Rebel and Wiggle, Worm Wiggle.

Here's hoping everyone had a fantastic Christmas and are now enjoying the delights (hopefully there are many) of 2014. Margaret and Bill of Armidale's Saintly Devil Dancers hosted a New Year's Eve dance in their woolshed which saw enough dancers for three squares and three callers in attendance. Everyone had a good time with square dancing, bush dancing and country music entertainment. Casual dress was in order and the country style atmosphere enabled all dancers (many were solo) to mix freely.

Thank you to all those people who have given me positive feed-back on my Review articles. So far there have been no negative responses, however, sometimes a negative can be a good thing because there is always something to learn and the best way to learn is from mistakes or errors, so feel free to advise me if I get it wrong.

This is a thought to ponder. There are usually more women than men dancers, so women have been encouraged to learn both "right" and "left" dance positions. In some cases there are women who have only learnt the "left" hand routine. In other cases there are some who prefer to only dance "left" hand. Men, on the other hand usually only get to learn the "left" hand position. The question arises "is it fair that a man has to sit out because a lady is dancing as a "left" hand dancer?" In a club situation the members can usually work it out for themselves and the men often like to take a break so are thankful they have the women to swap with. However at a convention or special dance the numbers are greater and women always seem to out-number the men. Should a lady give way to a man? For example in a square-up, three couples are up, with two ladies paired. Two men see the need to fill the square and offer to split the paired ladies making a four mixed-couple square. One of the ladies is adamant as she prefers to dance "left" hand, so one man has to sit down, whilst the other has to find another lady. If the rejected man could have danced "right" hand would he have been accepted? Is there a sense of discrimination there? Is there a protocol to abide by? Are women stopping men from dancing? Should all positions be available to both sexes? Do you agree that men should not be stopped from dancing, and that women should not sit out because there are not enough men? So what is the answer? If you would like to add your thoughts please feel free to do so. Let the debate beain!

### La RondUcate

Continued from the October issue of the ASDR. This article was taken with permission from Dancing Round NSW compiled by Lyn Yager Ladies: Ever felt like a rag doll when dancing? Men: Ever felt like you were dragging a bag of potatoes on a dance floor? John & Karen Herr now share some of their thoughts on this subject ...

### **Upper Body Spacing:**

The man's right hand should be placed over the lady's left shoulder blade. But, if that hand is over the upper part of the shoulder blade, then his tendency is to pull the lady's upper body in towards him. First, that causes the lady to lose her view of the world and sees only his chest. Secondly, after being pulled in, she instinctively tries to get back her freedom by leaning back which causes the man to pull in toward and over her, throwing her off balance, which throws him off balance, and in the end the man blames the lady for pulling him off balance, when it was originally his fault!

The man's right hand should be on the lower portion of (or just below) the lady's shoulder blade and the fingers should be together (for her comfort and for a better look). This allows the lady to present an upper back poise from the man. The real benefit of this position is in turning figures. When you think of a boy's toy top -- it is small at the bottom and big at the top, which gives it better gyroscopic spin. That is what we want too. This is even more important when we are doing the faster turns, like in pivots, and double reverse spins.

### **Sensing Body Movements**

Frame: If a couple is in closed position and the man starts side stepping to the left, and if his frame is weak, the lady will hardly notice that he is moving until she sees that he is moving, and then she responds, but slightly too late, and she ends up not quite in front of him anymore, (although she may exert herself more to keep up). Conversely, if his frame is firm (not rigid), she will feel that his whole upper body is moving and will correspondingly respond.

Promenade position: We normally use a "Semi-Closed Position (SCP)", nicknamed "Semi". Frequently, this is interpreted to include that the man and lady are hip-to-hip. We suggest that this be changed to man's hip slightly in front of the lady's hip, so that the lady's upper portion of her left leg is slightly behind and in contact with the back side of the upper portion of his right leg. This we call "Promenade Position". It has multiple benefits, one of which is that when the Continued page 25





### **Proposed Amalgamation**

The committee of the Square Dance Society of NSW Inc. is endeavouring to combine with the NSW Callers' Association and the NSW Round Dance Association Inc. Why, would they want to do this? Let's have a brief look at the history of the saugre dance society in New South Wales.

On 22nd July 1956 a meeting of square dancers was organised to form a society. It was planned so there would be a representative of every major caller on the committee. Over the next few years the format was changed to include the callers. In 1960-61 a Callers' Advisory Board was formed as part of the society. In 1970 it was decided there should be a round dance advisory committe which became part of the Callers' Advisory Board to advise on round dance matters. In 1976 the NSW Square Dance Callers Association was formed as a separate group to the Square Dance Society of NSW. In 1979 the Team Trainer's Association was formed as another group to organise competition dancing. So for the first twenty years dancers, callers and round dancers all belonged to the same organisation. Callers, such as Tom McGrath and Ron Jones had held positions such as president and vice president of this original society. So time moves on and the Round Dance Association became a separate group also.

Thirty-five years later we are asking you to consider rejoining the elements of our activity back together because all our associations are experiencing declining numbers and it is becoming more and more difficult to attract people to fill executive positions on various management committees. Amalgamation would reduce the number of office bearers required.

Our associations have common aims and objectives and to varying degrees, they are complimentary.

An amalgamated association would foster an opportunity to plan conventions and significant dances with a common aim and go a long way to avoiding conflict in the planning of these events. The new amalgamated association would be named to identify the groups/interests covered. The constitution would be a rewrite of an existing constitution to clearly identify aims and objectives of all groups included.

An amalgamation of this nature would reduce administrative workload and facilitate immediate answers where questions arise across group interests. This move could be a catalyst to revive our efforts toward common goals and it is suggested that this proposal is circulated to society members and hopefully lead

to a positive result The AGM at the State Convention would be an ideal time frame.

In summary, we believe this can only benefit all three associations for the following reasons.

- Access to a larger amount of funds for promotions.
- More people to fill executive positions (fresh ideas).
- More cohesive committee
- Communicate and make decisions more effectively.
- Minimize the number of meetings required for three associations
- More unified front for both square and round dancing.

man steps forward with the right foot, the lady instinctively will keep her upper lea contact and go with the man. In the SCP position, the man will step forward and the lady won't know until she sees him moving.

Rise & Fall: If a couple does not have a good frame, and they do not have their proper five points of contact, then when the man rises and falls (in waltzes and foxtrots), the lady is left to do her own rise and fall if so inclined. If done properly, the lady has no choice but to match his upward and downward movement.



increased. This is the feeling that we should have in most all of our Latin dancing. The lady depends heavily on a lead that comes from that firmness in the arms.

Back Poise Checking Action: In a Spin Turn, if we maintain a totally vertical position at the end of the 2nd step, we most probably will want to step forward for the last step. But, if we use a Back Poise at the end of the 2nd step, then taking the back step (3rd step) is much easier. This concept can apply generally to the checking action that we so often use. For example: If we walk and check to banjo (prior to a Fishtail), we must use a Back Poise on the checking step, otherwise we will want to step forward for the Fishtail. Concluding next issue

## EMERGENCY CALL FOR MEDICAL AID



When a dancer goes down, a second dancer attends him/her.

Remaining couples join hands and take a step backward. This will allow the injured person and attendant air and room.

Raise joined hands as high as possible in the form of an arched circle.

On seeing this signal, the caller or hall monitor will immediately place an Emergency Call for Medical Aid.
