BEHIND THE MIKE

Hello again,

Have you ever heard the myth that callers can't dance! I am here to tell you that, CALLERS CAN DANCE! Not only can they dance but they actually really enjoy it!!

The problem for a lot of callers is that they don't get to dance that often and especially at their our own club/s. Just about all callers were dancers first and then a bit later took up calling. As they got more involved with calling they got to do less dancing. It is a bit of a joke with dancers, I often hear when I get in a square stuff like, lookout we have callers in our square. The biggest problem I think is that callers don't just dance when given the opportunity. They are analysing the caller who is calling and trying to anticipate the routine instead of just relaxing and having an enjoyable dance. Sometimes we may be in a situation were we need to critique the caller later on.

Also what can happen when dancing to other callers is we are listening for interesting choreography, this is called research, but it is hard to take notes and dance at the same time. That's like talking and dancing at the same time, often tried but rarely successful. How often can a caller go to a dance and just dance and not have to worry about which bracket they are in and so on.

Higher ranked callers at National and State Conventions can find it tough to actually get much time to dance with their partners and their friends who more often than not are callers too! Sometimes people frown upon callers and partners squaring up together with their friends. But dancers do it all the time, what's the difference?

I remember in Darwin I got in a callers and partners square and it was a real HOOT! Everyone in the square just wanted to have fun and did just that!!



Figure B Heads Lead Right , Circle Four Halfway, Veer Left, Now Boys Circulate, while the Ladies Trade, Half Tag, Scootback, Split Circulate, Ladies s Run, Ladies Walk Across, Swing Corner, Promenade

Dance 2

Figure Heads Promenade Halfway, Square Thru Four, Touch a Quarter, Scootback, Boys Run, Pass the Ocean, All 8 Circulate, Swing Corner, Promenade



Upper Body Rotation:


In performing a "Wing to Sidecar", which is better? Forward with trail foot, then without rotating your body, crank the lady around you until she is on your left side, OR forward with trail foot leading the lady toward a pickup, then without changing your frame's relationship to your body, turn your upper body until she is in sidecar and you are facing Diagonal Centre. You are right!! #2 is the answer. When the man rotates the lady, the man should keep her in the same relative position to the man without bending ('breaking') the frame. This keeps




Tassie News



Why join the Square Dance Society of NSW?

As was mentioned in last month's Review the Society was formed in 1956 by a group of callers and dancers to ensure the continuity and development of the square dancing activity. A magazine or newsletter of one form or another has been produced by the Society since September 1956 as a line of communication between the Society and its member. Recently, this was taken over by the National Society. However, the NSW Society continues to pay for club news that is inserted by NSW clubs and charges a very small annual fee for clubs' diary listings. The Society also pays the postage to have the Review delivered to your club.

The Society, continues to run functions for the benefit of its members and other dancers with the support of callers and cuers. It assists with the running and organisation of State Conventions and the running of fifth Saturday dances. All members receive a discounted price to Conventions and Society dances.

The Society provides free promotional pamphlets, posters and a display stand to clubs to promote square dancing. The 1800 number which originated in NSW and is now used nationally assists the general public to source clubs and callers. The square dancing homepage put together by volunteers from each state to further the image of square dancing nationally and internationally. A new facebook page for the NSW Society (soon to be completed) and linked to the homepage will further enhance our image. Advertising in the Seniors magazine and The Bowls Plus NSW magazine also adds to this.

The Society has negotiated Public Liability and Personal Accident Insurance. The Personal Accident Insurance is included in your membership at no extra cost to dancers who are members.

By becoming a member of the Square Dance Society of NSW Inc. your contribution can help improve this activity through promotional activities that the Society undertakes. Our aim is to look after our members and provide them with greater scope to enjoy their dancing now and for future generations.

A motion will be put to the members at the AGM in April. Motion: The Committee of the Square Dance Society of NSW recommends that the annual membership fee increase by \$5.00 except for Category D.



her always in front of him, and she doesn't fall behind and have to try to catch up.

Dancing Through or By Your Partner:

Dancing By (outside partner): We can dance like a "barge going up stream", or we can dance like a "streamliner silent cruising". One key is to keep our hips out of the way of our partner. This requires tight crossing of thighs with belly-buttons facing each other. With this technique, we maintain the "feeling" of continuing to dance in closed position. The lead for this is with a hip-lead, which causes the partner step outside, ending in a "Feathered" position.

Dancing through (inside partner): In figures like "Open Impetus" and "Open Telemark", the driving partner needs to dance straight forward, and the other partner needs to turn out of the way. For example, in the Open Telemark, the man takes steps 1 and 2 straight forward, and at the same time must rotate the upper body Left Face with a firm frame, which causes the lady to step back totally out of the way with a heel turn. What does this mean? It means that the man did not step around the lady, but through her (or through where she WAS).

Practice: Here are a couple of challenges:

Whisk: Practice leading the lady into a "Whisk", rather than a "Hover". The man should try to cause the lady to hook her right foot in back in the Whisk. Pickup with Lock: Practice leading the lady into a "Wing to Sidecar", rather than a "Pickup Side Close". The man must use his frame and upper body rotation to perform the Wing.

Summary: Personally speaking, it took years before we finally learned how to dance "together", as a single unit. I had to learn to lead better, and Karen had to learn to follow whatever I did, even when I lead a figure that was not cued. Probably the most challenging technique for us was learning to Dance Outside Partner properly. BUT, once we came to that point, we found that we now enjoy dancing much more than we did before.

EMERGENCY CALL FOR MEDICAL AID



When a dancer goes down, a second dancer attends him/her.

Remaining couples join hands and take a step backward. This will allow the injured person and attendant air and room.

Raise joined hands as high as possible in the form of an arched circle.

On seeing this signal, the caller or hall monitor will immediately place an Emergency Call for Medical Aid.
