Tribute to Allan Frost Square Dance Caller S.A.



Allan Frost called for around thirty years and was one of Australia's finest square dance callers. This year he would have turned 100 years old on the 20th March. Allan started calling in S.A. when square dancing was in its infancy and aetting on its feet. One of his clubs was the "Southern Cross" which he started & ran for 20 years. He then took over the "Seacliff Weavers" club in 1973 from Roger Weaver & it was renamed "The Weavers" square dance club, where he called for some 18 years. That same year he was asked to run a dance for the YMCA at Elizabeth, where a club was

formed not long after & became known as the "Shooting Stars". Allan called for this square dance club on a fortnightly basis for about 10 years.

I started my first club in S.A. in 1973 which was the Wild Frontier Square Dance Club. With a lot of help & guidance from Allan, I got my new club off the ground and running. Allan gave me encouragement and helped me as a new caller which I have never forgotten. But it was Allan who really put S.A. on the square dance map by introducing a higher standard of calling and a higher level of dancing in this state. Allan was highly regarded throughout the country and a great draw card at our Australian National Conventions with his smooth style of calling & clear melodious singing voice.

A founding member of the South Australian Callers Association, the S.A. Square Dance Society and the Australian Callers Federation. He was a Life Member of all three bodies. He was also the convenor of the 1974-14th Australian National Sauare Dance Convention here in Adelaide.

I have invited Allan's son Raymond to add his personal tribute to his father & this has been attached to mine. Jeff Seidel

A Personal Tribute Continued

I have just turned 70 and it was only the first 21 years of my life that I actually lived with my parents Allan and Lorna Frost at our home in Adelaide. I will always remember as a kid growing up in Australia in the 50's, it was a dream of mine, as it was with many others of my generation, to travel to England on a working holiday.

My father and indeed my mother, always supported me in this dream, even though I always knew that they would have preferred that I stay at home. In all of the years that I lived away from home, neither of them once applied any pressure upon me to return home. This I really appreciated. I have spent the past 50 years living abroad, 9 of those years in England and the remainder in Canada.

Dad was always a pillar of strength for me and was blessed with the type of personality that people related to. His personality and ease in relating to others enabled him to become a successful square dance caller. Prior to his calling career he did of course participate in this activity as a dancer. Although young at the time I will always remember his introduction to square dancing in 1952.

Dad was never the type of person to attend dances but I remember an aunt of mine collaborated with my mother to have both of their spouses to attend an evening being held at a local church in Lockleys. Dad and my uncle were just told that it was a church event. Dad came home that evening absolutely elated with this new found activity (Square Dancing) and was really looking forward to return the following Saturday. Many of you know what that Saturday evening back in 1952 eventually led to, a second career as a Square Dance Caller. I would be remiss if I did not mention the incredible help and support given to Dad by my mother, which greatly contributed to his overall success in this endeavour.

Over the years my Dad made eight trips to Canada to stay with me and I returned to Australia many more times than that. These trips enabled us to stay close and in touch.

When Dad became stricken with cancer in 2000 I returned immediately to Australia and spent the last two weeks of his life at his bedside in hospital. During his hospitalization Dad was more concerned about others close to him than he was about himself. He was particularly concerned that I had travelled all this way just to spend most of my wakening hours at his bedside. I told him many times that he had cared and nurtured me for the first 21 years of my life and it Continued page 9



When a two ladies couple joins a square they should be made welcome. I say this because at times there are 'looks' and it has occurred that Boy/Girl couples left a square to make up a new square with other Boy/Girl couples. Not nice.

I myself was taught that it only takes one person to start a square and never to walk past an unfinished square. If eight people want to dance with each other they need to get up as a square, it saves embarrassment for those who are filling squares, only to be told that the spot is already taken. Basic Square Dance etiquette, which is readily available on the web.

When it comes to Lady Lefties, without them, many clubs would no longer exist. A Lady Lefty should not have to apologise, explain or defend her position. Perhaps we could use Beaus/Bows and Bells/Belles across the board?

(By the way, how often would it happen that two men are 'left-overs'??)

How You Can Help To Retain Dancers

This article was originally published in this magazine in the 1990's by Chris Froggatt and still has relevance to dancing today.

Some dancers leave our activity for reasons that are beyond anyone's control - factors such as health, moving, work, finances, age or a change in family situations. However, it could also be seen that there are some reasons that dancers "drop out" that we can do something about. This applies equally to newcomers as to established square dancers.

Let's look at some of these things in more detail, and see what we can do to prevent people leaving square dancing unnecessarily.

Joining The Club

As new comers discover our magical world of square dancing, they have a choice whether to stay or go. If they don't feel welcome or don't feel that they fit in, they may decide square dancing is not for them. On the other hand, they might get bitten by the square dance bug! There are three opportunities when we can either lose or retain dancers:

- * at the Beginner stage,
- * while they are learning to dance the club level, and
- * when they are established square dancers.

Square dancing is a skill, and these days it takes quite a commitment to master it. If a new dancer learns slowly or misses a lesson here and there, they will probably feel a little insecure, and may wonder if they will ever make it. The established club dancers must help them feel as confident as possible, by gently guiding them in the right direction, and assuring them that they will indeed "make it". All club members should mix and talk with the new dancers and try to establish a friendship with them. It is imperative that they feel welcome and "part of the group". I think that this is one of the great benefits of the "Round Up".

The Club's "Personality"

Thinking back to my early days as a dancer (BC - before calling) I can remember that some clubs had a reputation of being friendly, some had "top dancing", and some others seemed kind of elitist. The reputation was largely due to the club's members. After visiting the club, you made up your own mind whether the reputation was justified or not - and you soon knew if you would go back again.

In my opinion, the ideal club would be pleasant, friendly and welcoming to others. The members would support all club functions, set an example for others to follow, and "do unto others as you would want them to do unto you".

The club leaders (official or otherwise) can also add fun, fellowship and enjoyment to their club by smiling, being open and friendly and by being considerate of the feelings of others. On the other hand, they can congregate in closed circles and appear to be snobbish.

What can the caller do to help?

Obviously the caller has to take a large part of the responsibility for making sure dancers (new and established) are happy to stay. The caller's job does finish by making the dancing fun and stimulating. He/she should also come down off the stage and mix with the dancers when time allows, making sure not just to mix with a select few.

Actively seeking out the visitors to say hello, talking to the learners, giving them reassurance, listening to their requests and comments, and making sure that they are not left behind are some of the things a caller must also do. Callers should help to minimise cliques (without treading on personalities), and maintain enthusiasm within the club.

Some dancers need extra help. It is very important for the caller to encourage them, and not put them down. Find out which calls need a little extra work. Callers may also find that some dancers don't find the dance program "challenging" enough. It's hard to please everybody, but a part of the night can be put aside especially for more challenging calls (but not the whole night, the dancers need relaxation as well as stimulation).

Let's now look at some of the things that may contribute to people leaving the square dance activity (and maybe find ways to avoid doing these things).

Peer Pressure

This may happen when a group of experienced dancers (perhaps unintentionally) put pressure on friends to join them in dancing a level that they are not ready for. They feel that they can "pull them through" so everything will be all right. Believe me, this does not feel all right to the inexperienced dancer! They might make it through the bracket, but they will have no idea what they just danced. In addition, they might think that it is OK to join a higher level because they expect to be pulled through.

EMERGENCY CALL FOR MEDICAL AID



- When a dancer goes down, a second dancer attends him/her.
- Remaining couples join hands and take a step backward. This will allow the injured person and attendant air and room.
- Raise joined hands as high as possible in the form of an arched circle.
- On seeing this signal, the caller or hall monitor will immediately place an Emergency Call for Medical Aid.


