

BEHIND THE MIKE Gary Petersen – A.C.F. Public Relations

Hello again, By the time you read this you may be on your way or already in Hobart. In this article I will go over the correct procedure for Broken Squares. Yeah I know it doesn't happen very often but when it does you need to know what to do! There are two different procedures, depending on whether it is a 'Singing Call' or a 'Hoedown'. Generally at a National you get a three number bracket, the first is a 'Singing Call' {the ladies visit each man during the dance and end back at home}, the second is the 'Hoedown' where the caller will go through a few routines to either an Allemande Left with your Corner, a Right and Left Grand or back to Home. The third is another 'Singing Call'. I have seen squares that have broken down and instead of getting to lines quickly or getting back home they flounder around trying their own repair job into whatever formation they see other squares in and try to keep dancing. Please don't do this unless all of your square know what you are doing. It is much better to bite the bullet, make normal lines and are ready to go on the call 'Everyone forward and back' or in a Singing Call start from home.

Procedure to Repair a Broken Square

- (If your set breaks down}
- 1. As soon as possible return to your original "Home" position.
- 2. In a SINGING CALL, join in at the START of the next sequence, or the next "Allemande Left"

3. In a HOEDOWN Head ladies take their corner's hand and the Head Couples then back out to form two facing lines at the sides of the square. Wait for the caller to say: "Everybody, Lines Forward and Back"

Then you will be able to rejoin the dancing.

Till next time Bye Bye !!!!! See you in Hobart !!!!!!!

No one has explained it to me like this before so I thought I would repeat it here, as it may help other dancers -

1.All go to original "Home" position, as soon as possible. (Men go home & take a lady)

2. "HEAD" Ladies will take their Corners hand (let go of your partner) and the "Head" Couples will back out to form lines at the Sides of the square.

3. Wait for the Caller to call "Everybody, lines go forward & back" or "allemande left".

I am now in Tasmania and enjoying the scenery and wildlife. The weather has been good so I am hoping Hobart will turn on the sunshine. Looking forward to meeting up with everyone in June.

Keep smiling and enjoy your dancing.

Round Dance- for your Health and Happiness

You might be thinking that you are round dancing just for fun. "Smile," they say, "this is your recreation!" But you are dancing for your health, too. Round dancing is a perfect activity for improving physical, mental, emotional, social, and even artistic or creative health.

Physical Health Many people realize that they are dancing "for fun and for the exercise." They know that dancing is good for us. A waltz might flow along at 30 or more measures per minute. That's about 100 weight changes per minute. We don't walk or run or lift weights that fast. Dancing burns anywhere from 200 to over 2000 calories during a 30-minute period—as many as walking, swimming, or bicycling. Like some other forms of exercise, dancing is "wholebody." Of course, you are working your feet, ankles, legs, and hips, and you work different muscle groups when you dance backwards than when you go forward. But think too of what the maintenance of good posture and proper frame does for you—staying balanced, the use of body sway, counter sway, and contra-body position. There is probably no muscle in the body (and there are over 600 of them) that doesn't contribute its share to maintaining tone and smoothing and controlling the flow of the body around the floor

Mental Health Lately, we are hearing more and more that the very best form of exercise for the brain is dancing. It is the brain that coordinates the activity. Exercise increases blood flow to the brain so it can feed and breathe. Think of all that coordinated muscular activity, precise movements in specific sequences, finely meshed lead and follow, all this matched to one piece of music after another. Does this happen by itself? No, the brain and entire nervous system directs it in great waves of mental activity. How many different figures have we learned — and figure combinations, and dreaded modifications? Probably just as many as crossword puzzle clues or bridge hands. And we have to think fast. The cue comes, and we don't have the luxury of thinking it over and maybe looking it up in a manual. We have to process those hundreds of cues, one after the other. We coordinate with the music and at the same time with our partner. This is heavy-duty mental exercise.

I, and I know others, have noticed the lack of sashes being worn by the left hand dancer who is female. I greatly admire these ladies but being female in the left hand position and not wearing a sash can create problems, mainly if a square breaks down.

At the Convention in Kiama it was painfully obvious there was a problem with this. There were many round ups and I found on several occasions I was in a square with perhaps only one or two males and even a square where there was no male. No left hand dancer wore a sash. There was eight of us all looking the same! Although the dancing was good the squares did break down and it was extremely difficult to locate oneself, particularly if you did not know the people you were dancing with, and this was mainly the case. Even at club level sash wearing is dropping off.

For many years this has not been a problem but now I feel it should be reinforced so that the female left hand dancer does wear a sash.

I would be interested to know what others feel about this.

Sparkilate Square Dance Club

Another of Sparkilate's quite achievements was teaching Square Dancing at Hornsby Tafe College for four years. On graduation Fred would send his students on to the club closest to where they lived, not always the Sparkilate Club.

Fred read in the American Square Dance magazine 'Sets in Order' about calling for wheel chair squares in the USA and decided to give it a go in Australia. When he made enquiries to the States, he was advised that there is no way you can use singing calls for wheel chairs squares. So he took that on as a challenge, which he accomplished by allowing twice the number of beats for each movement, and used singing calls often. The 'Square Wheelers' as they were known danced for around ten years, which proudly included a demonstration at the 1988 Bicentennial National Convention at Homebush. One of Fred's many assistants with the Square Wheelers was Merle Myers who sometimes assisted with the calling.

One of Fred's background roles was supporting his wife Elizabeth as the Square Dance Society Ticket Secretary, a position she held for over 20 years. Elizabeth was also Treasurer for a couple of State Conventions.

Elizabeth and Fred were tireless workers in Square Dance promotions and they and their teams and regular dancers could always be found at any Society Promotion. Fred and Elizabeth encouraged their club to get involved at all levels including demonstrations at State and National Conventions. Some of these included the Minuet complete with period costumes and period wigs, hand made wigs by Ruth Krix, for the Minuet, and danced by around 20 to 30 club members and the Zombie Jamboree danced by eight Sparkilate club members in hand made Glowing Skeleton Costumes.





When a dancer goes down, a second dancer attends him/her.

Remaining couples join hands and take a step backward. This will allow the injured person and attendant air and room.

Raise joined hands as high as possible in the form of an arched circle.

On seeing this signal, the caller or hall monitor will immediately place an Emergency Call for Medical Aid.
