BEHIND THE MIKE

Hi everyone and thanks for tuning into the latest news from the Australian Callers Federation. At the National Convention in Adelaide there were a few major changes on the ACF Board. Your new secretary (Jeffrey Garbutt), CallerLink Editor (Jim Buckingham) and Historian (Kevin Kelly) are settling into their positions and emails have already been flowing with ideas and follow-on business arising from the General and Board Meetings that were held. It's time to start looking ahead to next year and it's shaping up to be a very busy one.

2016 ACF Caller/Cuer Conference

Some dancers are unaware of the work that callers put in behind the scenes, like attending training (often at their own expense) to improve their skills and aive their dancers a better dance experience. Every 4 years the ACF holds an International Conference. The last one was in Hobart in 2012 and the next one is at the Mantra Resort in Mooloolaba, Queensland from the 26th to the 28th of June - preceding the 2016 National Convention. Presenters will be Paul Bristow (U.K.), Ken Ritucci (USA) and our own Steve Turner (Aus). Steve is the only Australian Caller Coach Accredited by Callerlab. (The International Association of Square Dance Callers) The advantages over other caller schools is that the ACF are providing world class presenters and much of the cost is being met by ACF Funds. Other caller schools can be attended anytime through the year so please encourage your club caller to take up this once in a four year opportunity. If you're a caller and you've not yet registered for this Caller/Cuer conference, do it quickly. The Mantra Resort are graciously offering a discount to all square dance callers/cuers and dancers attending either the caller/cuer conference or the 57th National Convention. To get the discount, you must use the special form on the website below. The resort is filling fast so please consider booking as soon as possible. 

The first night we had square dancing with Nev McLachlan in the "Shall We Dance" lounge and with six sets of both mainstreamers and beginners, we started doing the basic moves and we were having so much fun, we didn't want it to stop. However, there was a band on after us, so we had to continue on day two.

Square Dancing Market Research

American and Australian attitudes about Square Dancing may be similar. by John Brant

A public relations and research company in Sydney, Australia conducted a survey of Australians in New South Wales. The purpose was to find out what the current perspective of the general public is of Square Dancing and how to improve it. The results of that survey may be relevant to the attitudes of Americans. The rise and decline of Square Dancing in both countries has been similar. It became popular at the same time and now has primarily older people participating in both countries. The survey results might be helpful in determining how to market Square Dancing to the public.

The original survey found the following:

* Only 11% of people had not heard of square dancing. However, their understanding of what square dancing really is was poor. Most thought of it as a "red neck" hillbilly activity.

- * 41% had done something they thought was square dancing at school.
- * Only 2% saw it as good exercise.

* 67% of the population have a negative image of square dancing.

What they disliked (even if never tried it)

* Music 25%, too rigid traditional 24%, need a partner 15%

* Of those surveyed, 45% said they would give it a go if at a suitable time and near to them.

*In country areas this increased to 56%, and for 20 year old University student 46% would try, general public 35%, and older people only 25%

* Preferred time for classes and social dancing: 70% early evening soon after work (7-9PM). Only 15% of prospects are prepared to take it up between 8-10PM.

* Preferred venue: 70% prefer air-conditioned clubs that serve low cost food (sports clubs and the like) Only 10% of prospects are happy with church halls, and a further 20% are happy with school halls.

* Of the 45% of the population prepared to Square Dance, by running the dances from 8-11PM the percentage dropped to 7%, and by using church halls the part of the population attracted to square dancing dropped down to 0.7%.



With two square dance slots-10am and again at 8pm, this gave us all the chance to check out the other entertainment, such as Amber Lawrence or just shop at the ship's shops or explore the ship. So much to see and do away from all the entertainment. Our headliner act this day was the Bellamy Brothers from the USA.

We had bus transfers from the ship to the centre of town to do some shopping or buy duty free items. As we had rain we were unable to have a band on pool deck for safety reasons. But the bar was doing all right. The theme tonight was country and our headliner act tonight was Graeme Connors.


