By the time you read this most callers who attended the conference and convention in Tassie are home again and ready to put their new skills to practice. It is also that time of year where we are looking for your update and renewal forms to be returned to your State Coordinator in a timely manner with your memberships, APRA Fees as well as updated information on your contact details, both physical and ELECTRONIC if applicable. Most communication these days is electronic, so don't forget to notify ALL your contacts when changing email accounts.

If you pay through associations like ACA, ARDA or state associations etc. the APRA license fee is NOW \$60 if received before the 1st August. For all non members who pay direct to the ACF as an individual the APRA license fee is \$65. A late fee of \$5 still applies to payments received after the 1st of August. for associations it is NOT recommended to delay your bulk payment waiting for the stragglers.

Payments / deposits can be made directly into the ACF Bank Account, which is, Australian Callers Federation BSB 4420; # 10028195. Please use your name and state as a reference, then send an email to the ACF Secretary Nev McLachlan (nevbevmclachlan@bigpond.com) as well as the ACF Treasurer Howard Cockburn (hcockbur@bigpond.net.au)

Don't forget that any changes made on your update and renewal forms have to be legible. The information is for both your state body as well as the ACF Registrar. IF THEY CAN NOT READ IT THEY CAN NOT MAKE THE REQUIRED CHANGES. Bye Bye !!!!!!

On Friday many dancers enjoyed an official visit to Government House where Governor Peter Underwood told of his early association with square dancing and wished us all well whilst in Tasmania.

### A.P.R.A.

The Australian Callers Federation's negotiated agreement with the Australian Performing Rights Association allows the ACF to collect fees from callers and clubs for a licence to broadcast and perform the music and lyrics of composers, lyricists and publishers who own the rights to such material.

The APRA licence fee is payable before the end of July each year and it is the responsibility of all participants to register and pay accordingly.

For 2012 the fee structure remains unchanged: \$60 if paid through the callers association in your state, \$65 if paid directly to the ACF.

Then there's Luce's law: "No good deed goes unpunished." And if you don't believe that you should try running a square dance for a couple of years. I wonder if Luce was a caller?

Everybody seems to have got into the act, even Daizy. After driving to square dances all over the country Daizy's Law states, "You always catch the slowest semi-trailer at the end of the passing lane."

My friend Dodgy was a systems analyst for an international airline. He spent his working week flying around the world designing computer programs. Tough life, huh? Dodgy was always fascinated when he returned to an office after some months to find that people often worked out how to use his programs to do things he hadn't even considered.

Now there's an idea.

Have you ever noticed how creative some dancers become? They do unexpected things (like weaving the ring in the wrong direction or trying to start a do paso with their corner) and, when the square breaks down, giggle nervously and expect everybody to forgive them.

We only need to apply Dodgy's Revelation to that sort of situation and we get Dozy's Law. – "If there is only one possible way to interpret a call somebody will always find an alternative."


