BEHIND THE MIKE

From the Past: 2014 marks the 35th Anniversary of the ACF. It was officially created on the 25th of September 1979 by a group of Aussie callers looking for ways and means of how things could be improved for the benefit of square dancing and dancers in Australia. Following from a discussion over a pie and a beer or two, Wally Cook, Jeff Seidel and Jack Murphy drew up a list of callers - noting what they had been doing for the movement in their state and nationally, together with their ability to call. A shortlist of two callers from each state was drawn up (except Victoria) and, because of fractions that needed to be considered, five from Victoria. South Australia was to host the 21st National Square Dance Convention in 1980 and this was an opportune time to present the newly formed callers body to the rest of the callers and the dancers. Invitations were sent out to invite callers to join this new body named the Australian Callers Federation (the name was suggested by Ron Jones N.S.W)

From the past to the present: It is that time of year again where we are looking for your update and renewal forms to be returned to your state representative with your memberships and APRA Fees. Encourage your new callers to become members of the ACF and save money by purchasing your APRA licence as well (taking advantage of the bulk buying power of the ACF)

From the present to the future: There is now a website for details of the ACF Caller / Cuer Conference being held in Buderim just prior to the 57th Australian National Square Dance Convention in 2016. Letter To The Editor

Chris Froggatt's article in the July Review debates whether the "Square Dance" name is the reason people are hesitant to join or maybe it's the level they are expected to reach. The idea of teaching to an enjoyable level and then providing dances to suit so everyone has a good time, sounds good. Unfortunately, most clubs do not have the numbers to separate the dancers into varying 'level' groups and so clubs and dancers will need to remain flexible. If you enjoy the sport of Square Dancing don't be afraid to shout it from the roof tops and tell people what they are missing out on. The name "Square Dancing" is known World-wide so why change it, just change the way in which we promote and teach Square Dancing.

Solo Dancers

Hello fellow dancers. The Solo Dancers message will only appear in the Review four times a year (management decision) so I will try to cover topics of interest concisely. May I ask Solo Dancers who would like to dance in the Dress Set Parade at the Adelaide Convention and who will not be in a set with their club to please contact me, by phone or email, so we can start arranging outfits, partners etc. Perhaps we'll have enough for two squares.

Just recently I became aware why unfamiliar calls create problems. I believe the way people learn varies. Some easily understand just the words whilst others have to see the "picture". I am a "picture" person. I can grasp concepts easier when I see the form it makes. Square Dancing is full of concepts. The Caller's words are taken in by the brain which, after digestion, enables the required action. Simple for those who only need the words for action, but for the "picture" person the process is a little longer. Once a move is grasped during the learning cycle, it functions easily until the move is changed, even slightly, and the "picture" becomes distorted. Extra time is required for the "picture" to become clear but during a dance there is no extra time and consequently a call is missed and a breakdown occurs. So be tolerant of other dancers and acknowledge that if a square breaks down it may not be that a dancer doesn't know the move, it could be that the brain just needs a bit more time. You only have to witness what happens when everyone expects to circle to the left and a circle to the right is called.

In Canberra it was good to watch the young ones really enjoying their dancing. Callers "please don't allow dancers to exit the floor unless they have a smile on their face". Next time I'll tell you how they dance in the UK and whether it was easy for me, as a solo dancer, to have a dance. I know they cross hands in front when promenading so that will be different. Happy times to all.

Keep smiling.

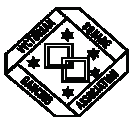

No I'm not talking about head banging music that makes the car rock a kilometre away just upbeat modern music. The music I use at a high school is slightly different to the music I use in a primary school.

Yes, I agree we have to acknowledge our music of the past but we need to be prepared to make changes to modern music if we wish square dancing to continue in the future and attract new dancers. After all variety is the spice of life! We need variety to keep our dancers interested and enthused.

I would like to hear other callers' comments regarding music.

EMERGENCY CALL FOR MEDICAL AID



- 1 When a dancer goes down, a second dancer attends him/her.
- 2 Remaining couples join hands and take a step backward. This will allow the injured person and attendant air and room.
- 3 Raise joined hands as high as possible in the form of an arched circle.
- 4 On seeing this signal, the caller or hall monitor will immediately place an Emergency Call for Medical Aid.
