# BEHIND THE MIKE

The ACF is "alive and well" today due to a small group of callers getting together 35 years ago to discuss ways of improving the way Nationals were programmed. Jeff Seidel was one of the three in this original group. Not only is 2014 a milestone for the ACF, but it is also a milestone for Jeff as he has been a board member since its inception. In 1990 all the original board members were awarded Life Membership in recognition of their contribution.

In its early years, meetings were held twice a year; one at the National Convention and one about half way between the next. These days most business is discussed via email, reducing the need for more than one meeting. The A.C.F. also started its own newsletter, come note service, then called "News & Notes" and was later renamed "Caller Link". Steve Turner was the first editor of this service. Caller Link continues today with Jeffrey Garbutt at the helm, delivering information for callers and news from all the states to all members.

You can assist the organisers of our National Conventions by registering early. Callers and cuers have only one month left to register their interest (up until 30th September) while Early Bird registrations to dance have been extended to the 31st of December for the upcoming 56th ANSDC in Adelaide. ## The Sound of Square Dancing – another view

Music inspires me. Music moves me. If we just executed choreography, we'd be playing chess.

I love music and more so I love what it does to the human soul. It lifts, it calms, it makes you cry, it makes you happy, it makes you wanna get up and dance!

I was interested to read the article by my amphibian friend Chris Froggatt. Well put Chris and there's nothing like a well written piece to inspire a healthy discussion.

Here goes...

It's a crazy constantly changing world isn't it? I remember as a kid sitting in front of the black and white telly and watching episodes of "Hee Haw" and the Channel 9 Country music hour. We thought that was great - and it was in its time. Now, when a friend discovers I square dance, a well meaning "yee hah" and a slap of the knee prompts me to want to hit him with a wet bale of hay.

I would have to say that if it wasn't for the sheer variety in music now available to us, I possibly may have drifted from square dancing - just possibly. Don't get me wrong, I love the choreography, the friendships and the really great suppers (!!). It's all part of the mix that keeps us there. I find though that music is a real motivator and what I enjoy is not just "doof doof", rock'n'roll, disco, jazz, crooning, ragtime - nah - I love it all! (And, it doesn't all have to be doof doof by the way to be different.)

What a smorgasbord of music we have available to us in this day and age. What a musical feast for the ears! As much as I'll vary choreography in a night to suit the mood, I definitely vary the music styles. I recall many years ago talking to a well known travelling American caller and he was remarking how much joy he gets from being able to manipulate a mood of a group through careful use of choreography and music. I was beginning to wonder about this accurate description of a power tripper then having danced at all sorts of conventions, festivals, clubs and weekends I can see and feel that sentiment. A big part of what makes for a great dance experience is the feeling you've been on a journey of highs and lows, light and shade and even travelled musically in time. What a rush!

I don't mind country music. I have even been caught tapping my toes to a banjo and fiddle piece. I have this type of music in my collection too - somewhere. It forms part of a mix of styles I have to offer. And that's the point - it's part of a wide mix of styles I now have. Even Mozart and Vivaldi get airplay - Bless 'em!

I also think that part of what Chris was reflecting on too was the "style" associated with square dancing. You can't escape its roots. It was based in country/bluegrass origins. People wore gingham and said "Yee hah" every darn chance they got. I tend to think that was not just square dancing, it was a more widely accepted image in the 1940s, 50s and 60s. Time, lifestyles, fashion and music have all evolved since then. Not wanting to dismiss any of our heritage I think we can evolve too.

I find these days for example, there are plenty of outfits that look smart but don't make you look like one of the Sons of the Pioneers. It's easy for us boys - we can go to a shop and pick a smart shirt off the rack that looks good for most other events too. Ladies I see are varying their style of skirts and dresses too. I think if we lock ourselves into the "country" style, we can tend to alienate our potential market.

Dad: "Look kids, we used to do that at school".

Kid: "Whatever!"

We can still look and sound up to date without compromising what we are. You can lose the gingham but you can't take our soul! Square dancing will still be square dancing – we dance in a square formation, use the standardised choreography and follow a well established format. Don't forget a lot of the choreography has its roots in the early days of square dancing and still honours those days.

There's no right or wrong in this, just varied opinions.

Now if you'll excuse me I need to iron my Calvin Klein shirt and prepare to present my latest Lady GaGa rendition of a hurtin' cheatin' blues baroque jive song.

### EMERGENCY CALL FOR MEDICAL AID



- 1 When a dancer goes down, a second dancer attends him/her.
- 2 Remaining couples join hands and take a step backward. This will allow the injured person and attendant air and room.
- 3 Raise joined hands as high as possible in the form of an arched circle.
- 4 On seeing this signal, the caller or hall monitor will immediately place an Emergency Call for Medical Aid.
