BEHIND THE MIKE

Hello everyone, by the time you read this article most clubs will be starting to wind down for the Christmas break.

During the break I would like to open a can of worms. Have you ever had any issues in your club because of attitudes and or snide comments? Have you ever had issues within your club because of the dance levels? When is it advisable to encourage newer dancers to attend big dances like a state convention or a national convention? One, two or three years?

Back when I started square dancing in the 90's attitudes were very different to now. As a beginner you were nurtured and encouraged and most people said that in the first year you learnt the calls and the second year you learnt to dance them. Because you were a representative of your club {once badged up} you needed permission from your caller to visit other clubs. If you asked about learning the next Level {Plus} you were advised if and when it may be happening and whether you were good enough to be in the class. The problem these days is that dancers are climbing the square dance ladder TOO quickly and also forgetting the levels below. The first call in every level of square dancing is dancer naming.

Our motto is "Fun and Friendship Set to Music"! Newer dancers worst enemies are actually their new friends. Because their friends are dancing a few nights a week they are encouraged to do the same as soon as possible. If their friends are dancing Plus the newbies are encouraged to learn ASAP. Somewhere along the line club loyalty and ethics come into it. Have you ever used the sentence, "my dancers don't do that". So far I have not seen any contract that gives any club or caller ownership of dancers! I say that dancers 'speak with their feet'! If their feet are happy, you'll see them. Dancers will discover new levels when they are good and ready, don't push them, let them enjoy their journey through square dancing!

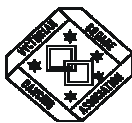

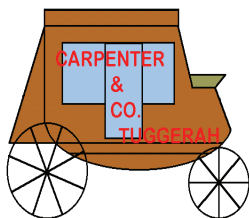

EMERGENCY CALL FOR MEDICAL AID



- 1 When a dancer goes down, a second dancer attends him/her.
- 2 Remaining couples join hands and take a step backward. This will allow the injured person and attendant air and room.
- 3 Raise joined hands as high as possible in the form of an arched circle.
- 4 On seeing this signal, the caller or hall monitor will immediately place an Emergency Call for Medical Aid.

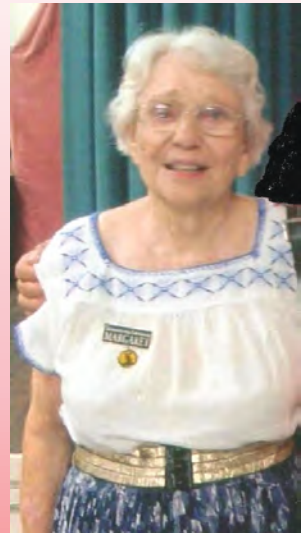
