

What did we have to show after Ten weeks of lessons for beginner dancers?.

At week ten we presented 25 certificates to acknowledge their Introduction to Modern Square Dancing. During the lessons approximately 30 movements were taught.

19 dancers have danced at Clubs around Brisbane and on the Gold Coast.

4 or 5 are still to decide where to go or have decided not to commit to club dancing at this time.

2 from local newspapers


2 from internet searches


